English


For the Autumn term, Year 1 will be looking at the following traditional tales;

We will be revisiting phonics phase 2 and 3 as well as moving on to phase 5 towards the end of the half term. Using our phonic knowledge we will be writing simple sentences.

We will also be reading **Lost and Found** by Oliver Jeffers.



Science

Our Science topics for the autumn term we will be focusing on **Animals including Humans**. We will identify a variety of common animals and talk about their eating habits and structure.



Topic – Who am I?

History – We will learn about significant people from the local areas.

Geography - We will explore our surroundings and begin to use key words to describe direction.

Music – We will listening to music and discuss the different instruments and voices, using xylophones to play and listen to different notes.

Art – We will be studying spirals through the artist Molly Haslund.

Design and Technology – We will be looking at how was a range of materials to design and make a product and making decisions based on the strength of the material.

Spanish – We will understand how to say and write greetings, animal names, and numbers 1-6, as well as developing and our knowledge of the different languages spoken by children in the school.

In the Autumn term, we will be covering the following Maths units:


- **Number: place value within 10**

The Great Fire of London




English

We will use the following books to further develop reading and comprehension skills and for a stimulus for writing.


Vlad and the Great Fire of London

R.E. – We will be thinking about how we can make people feel welcome and how traditions in Christianity and Islam show this.



The highlight of his stay is a trip to some distant caves where he sees some amazing cave paintings, meets a ferocious bear...and falls back into the twenty first century.

Briggs lives in a small, grey room in a large, grey city. When he finds a book in the library labelled 'Do Not Read', he cannot resist taking it home. In it, he comes upon pictures of bright, vibrant objects called flowers. He cannot find flowers anywhere in the city, but stumbles instead on a packet of seeds.

Science

P.E. – We will be developing our teamwork skills in competitive games, through gymnastics, football and multi-skills.


I.T. – We will use survey tools such as Google Forms and present information using slide software.



Year 4 will be reading:


The Pied Piper

impacted the world with their music and playing the glockenspiel.


Art – We will be studying how to story tell through Art through the work of Laura



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
The Man who Walked Between the Towers

The Nowhere Emporium




A Range of Greek Myths


