

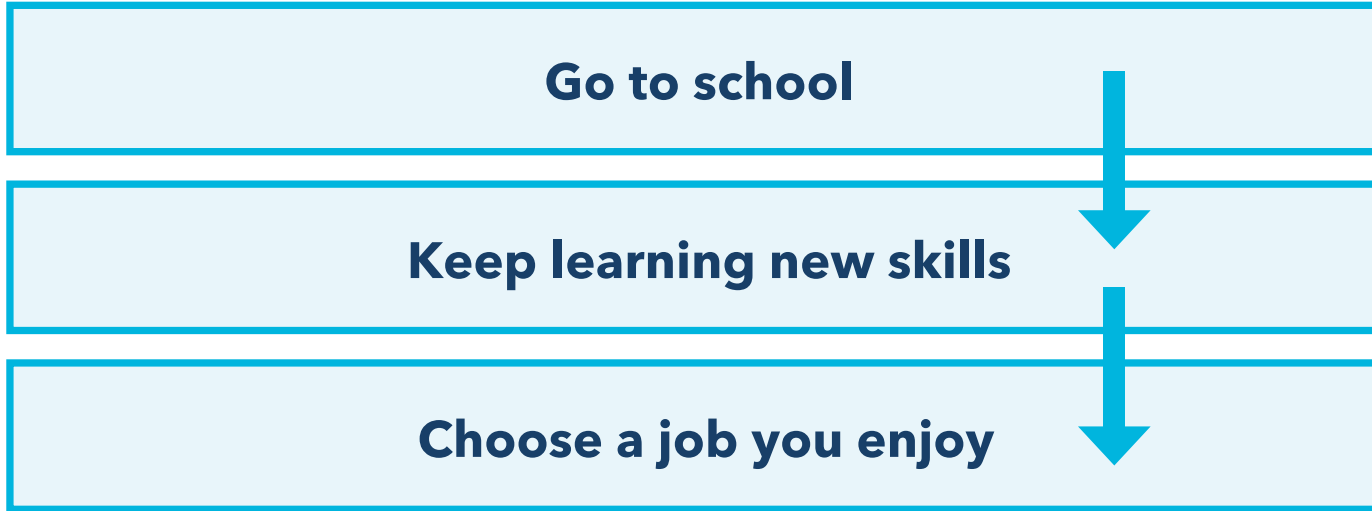
Jobs in Leeds | What could you be when you grow up?
